



Travel information from Nice to Peyresq, Alpes de Haute-Provence, France

This information assumes that most speakers will travel to Peyresq by plane to Nice, train to Annot and taxi from Annot to Peyresq.

Nice Airport – Train Station “Gare de Provence” (not SNCF but Chemins de Fer de Provence)

There are two terminals and from both terminals the bus number 99 goes directly to the central SNCF train station “Gare de Nice Ville”. The bus 99 departs every 30 minutes, the ride takes 20 minutes, the tickets costs about €4 and you can buy it from the bus driver. There is another connection to the train station with the local bus number 23 which takes a bit longer but you see more of Nice.

To find the bus: After arrival turn left in the arrival hall Terminal 1 and leave the arrival hall by the left exit (showing the number A0) to the bus stops. In case you arrive at Terminal 2 take the shuttle bus to Terminal 1. Please pass all the bus stops till you reach the last one – stop number 6 – from which the local bus number 23 is departing at least every 14 minutes, on Sunday at least every 18 minutes. Your ride from the airport to the central station called “Gare de Nice Ville” will take approximately 40 minutes and you can buy the bus ticket from the bus driver for about €1.

From the central train station “Gare de Nice Ville” you have three possibilities to reach the train you have to take at the “Gare de Provence”, rue Alfred Binet, which is the station of the “Chemins de Fer de Provence” : 1) walk about 12 minutes; 2) taxi; 3) one station with the tram number 1 from “Gare Thiers” to “Libération”. Note that there is no luggage deposit at this small station but you can leave your luggage at a luggage locker at the SNCF station.

Gare de Provence – Annot

Trains to Annot depart from the Station “Gare de Provence” NOT the central SNCF train station “Gare de Nice Ville” (see above). You can also find its location in Google maps (at 4 bis rue Alfred Binet - 06000 Nice) or at <http://en.nicetourisme.com/practical-advice/1288>.

Do NOT get off at the Peyresq station.

Please note that there five trains to Annot each day: 0625, 0850, 1255, 1715 and 1813, arriving 0812, 1039, 1444, 1904 and 2001. The full train timetable is attached and can be found at:

You can buy your ticket at the station (or on the train if you do not have sufficient time). The normal price (single) is €1.60 but there are reduced prices for students and passengers older than 55.

Annot to Peyresq

You will be taken by taxi from Annot to Peyresq. Annot is a small station: there will not be a taxi waiting for you unless it has been ordered in advance. Please stay in front of the station in Annot where you will be picked up.

Just in case

In case your airplane is delayed and you would not have enough time to get to the Gare de Provence you have a second chance to jump on the train at another station on the outskirts of Nice: take a taxi to the station Lingostière which takes about 10-15 minutes from the airport. The train stops at Lingostière 15 minutes after leaving the Gare de Provence.
